"Digital Biomimetics – Concepts for predictive treatments"

Jan-Frederik Güth (Dr. med. dent.) graduated from the D.M.D. School of Dental Medicine, Ludwig-Maximilians University, Munich, Germany. He holds the position of Deputy Director of the Department of Prosthodontics of the Dental School of the Ludwig-Maximilians University Munich. Dr. Güth defended his "Habilitation" in 2014 and received the title "Privatdozent". During 2013 he spent a research-stay (visiting professor) at the University of Southern California (USC; Pascal Magne). He is a member of the German Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Medicine (DGZMK), the German Association of Prosthetics and Bio-Materials (DG-Pro) and the German Association of Implantology (DGI). His main field of focus and area of research is digital impression technology and connected workflows across teeth and implants, CAD/CAM-technology, and high-performance polymers. Dr Guth is an internationally noted lecturer and publisher of scientific and clinical articles.

"Clear Aligners and Aesthetic Finishing: An Ultra Conservative Approach"

In 2012, Dr. Yvonne King became the first dentist in Australia to hold the prestigious Masters Degree in Aesthetic Dentistry from King's College in London. She is an honoured Life Member and Diplomat of World Congress of Microdentistry, and also a member of the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry, as well as a member of the Academy of Laser Dentistry. Dr King is responsible for introducing exciting technologies to Australian dentistry, being the first to utilise, in surgery teeth whitening, intra-oral cameras, and the first dentist Australia-wide to routinely use the WaterLase and Hoya-ConBio DeLight soft and hard tissue lasers. She is also an accredited trainer in Laser and Minimally Invasive Dentistry. She is Clinical Director for GlamSmile Porcelain Veneers in Australia and New Zealand, and is responsible for training dentists from around the world. Dr King and her work have been showcased in mass media including television, print magazines and radio.

“Taking the Mystery out of Occlusion in Implant Dentistry”

Baldwin Marchack graduated from the Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC and in 1989 received his MBA from the Anderson Graduate School of Management at UCLA. He is a Fellow of the American College of Dentists, the International College of Dentists, and the Pierre Fauchard Academy. Dr Marchack is a member of the Academy of Prosthodontics, the International College of Prosthodontists and the Academy of Osseointegration. He is also past-president of the American Prosthodontic Society, the Pacific Coast Society for Prosthodontics and the American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry and the International Federation of Esthetic Dentistry. Dr Marchack is a former Examiner for the California State Board of Dental Examiners, and he is an Honorary Member of the American College of Prosthodontists. He serves on the Board of Councilors for the Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC and is the Course Director for the USC Esthetic Dentistry Training Program in Hong Kong and course director for the USC Comprehensive Surgical and Restorative Implant Dentistry Training Program in Hong Kong. He has served as Chair of the Editorial Council for the Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry, and he maintains a private practice in Pasadena, California.

Dr Fibishenko attained his primary dental qualifications from the University of Melbourne and pursued further education in oral implants early in his career. He now practices exclusively in Oral Implantology, Dento-Facial Surgery and Facial Aesthetics and is one of Australia’s leading implant surgeons and educators. Dr Fibishenko is the founder of All-On-4 Clinic and co-founder of Facelab, the facial aesthetics arm of his clinics. He is a visiting lecturer at NYU College of Dentistry Linhart CDE Program, a Fellow of ICOI and an accredited member of numerous implant educational organisations including the American Academy of Facial Esthetics (AAFE). He is a key opinion leader and a frequently invited speaker internationally on advanced surgical concepts in dental implants.

He is currently the President of the American College of Prosthodontists, a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics, a Fellow of the American College of Prosthodontists and the Academy of Prosthodontics. He is also the Associate Editor for the Aesthetics/Prosthetics/Restorative section at the Journal of Dental Traumatology and a reviewer for the Journal of Prosthodontics and the Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry. Dr. Baba has received several honors and awards, is the author of numerous publications and has lectured globally.

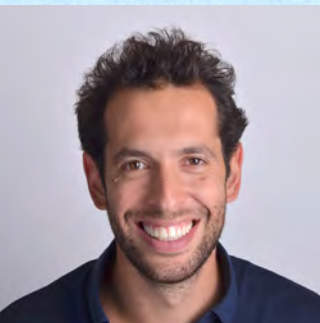

“Best Mechanics for Severe Crowding Correction”

Dr. Xu is a professor of orthodontics at the Peking University School of Stomatology and an adjunct professor of Case Western Reserve University. He works part time at Chinese Stomatological Association as an associate secretary-general and executive director of a scientific program for FDI 2020. He is a WFO councillor, AAO member and EOS member. He is well published in Chinese and International orthodontic Journals. He is an associate chief editor of Chinese Journal of Orthodontics, also serves on OCR and EJO editorial boards and yhe AJODO editorial review board. His research interests focus on 4D orthodontics and the investigation of clinical orthodontic outcomes. He emphasizes the effects of physiologic characteristics of dentition and craniofacial growth on orthodontic treatment and lectures on physiologic anchorage control globally.

He is currently an ITI fellow and speaker (International Team for Oral Implantology), a member of the American Dental Club Of Paris, and of +EAO (European Academy of Osseointegration). His private practice in Paris is limited to surgical and restorative implant rehabilitations.

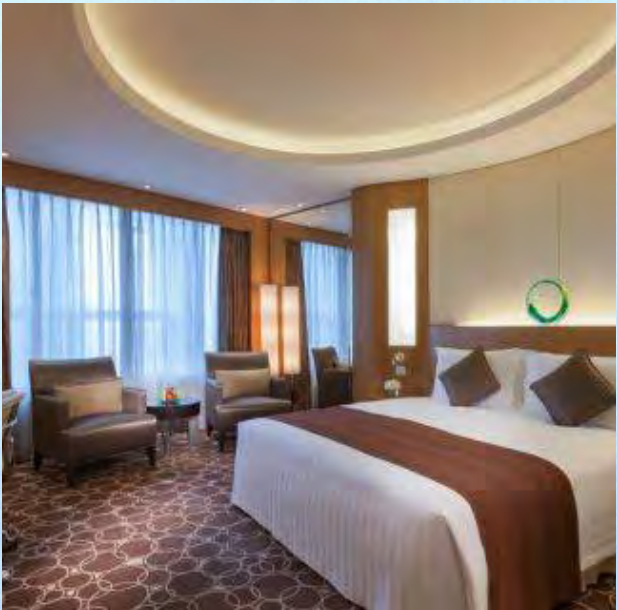
Futian Shangri-La Shenzhen

SIGHTSEEING OPTIONS

Shenzhen Overseas Chinese Town East



Overseas Chinese Town East (OCT East) covers an area of nine square kilometers. At Da Mei Sha of Shenzhen, a large ecological resort brimming with natural landscapes, small towns of Western and Oriental styles, and a cluster of entertainment facilities awaits you. It has three themed parks: Knight Valley, Tea Stream Valley, and Wind Valley as well as two, 18-hole golf courses. Visitors can also pay homage to Buddhist statues at Huaxing Temple and revel in performances played in the resort every day. Be impressed by the Heavenly Zen troupe, a dancing performance showcasing the Chinese tea culture; and Roaring Flood, a live-action stunt show.

Shenzhen Museum



The Shenzhen Museum was founded in 1981 and consists of three museum sites including the Museum of Ancient Art, the Historical Folk Culture Museum and the Dongjiang Guerrilla Command Memorial Museum. The Museum covers an area of more than 50,000 square meters and serves the function of collection, protection, research, display, and education of pieces. As a large-scale headquarter-division museum, it is honored as a museum at national level and is a National Red Tourism Classic Tourist Attraction.

Window of the World



Shenzhen's Window of the World, is one of Shenzhen's most famous attractions. A theme park featuring large-scale replicas of international tourist sights, it is located next to Shenzhen Happy Valley, in Overseas Chinese Town (OCT). A beautiful bay covering an area of 480,000 square meters in the western part of Shenzhen. The park carries forward the theme of world culture, showing world-famous landscapes, natural scenery, and daily performances of folk customs, folk songs and dances. It is a great place to take the family, especially young children, to experience and learn about our world's diverse cultures.

DongMen



Dongmen Pedestrian Precinct is a commercial area in Luohu that's been ticking away for over 300 years and has long been one of Shenzhen's most popular places for fashion shopping. If you enjoy a bargain, this is the place to find a treasure or two, but there's also plenty of luxury items to be found at great prices.

Lou Hu Commercial City



Luo Hu Commercial City is one of Shenzhen's most well-known shopping locations due to its location, size and diverse range of goods on offer. It is located at the Luohu Border, directly across from the Shenzhen Railway Station, and features five floors packed with independent retailers selling a range of goods including men's, women's and children's fashion, electronics, toys, watches, jewelry, craft, massage services and much more.

Splendid China Folk Culture Village



Whether you are interested in historical architecture, beautiful scenery or existing culture, Splendid China Folk Culture Village has something for everyone. Splendid China in Shenzhen is split into two parts. One part is the Folk Culture Village, and the other one is Miniature China. The theme parks are both about China, however they are quite distinct. One instructs on China's ethnic groups, and the other tours famous sites and architectural heritage at a scale of 1:15. For a quick tour of China in a day, visit the miniature models of important sites in Miniature China and then take a tour of China's many ethnic groups at the Folk Village. Your ticket covers you for both parts of the park. The Folk Culture Village features ethnic village settings with locals dressed in ethnic costumes, with a range of acrobatic, dance and musical performances. Visitors can also take advantage of sampling the cuisines of many different regions. A tour not to be missed if you want to learn about the essence of traditional Chinese culture.

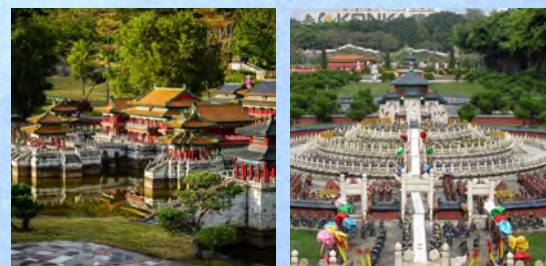
